#### North Carolina State Bar Application for Recertification as a Specialist

- 1. <u>Standards</u> Read the North Carolina Plan of Specialization and the standards for recertification in your specialty area. These materials are found at 27 N.C.A.C. 1D, Sect. 1700 *et seq.* and are published in the North Carolina State Bar *Lawyer's Handbook* and on our website, www.ncbar.gov.
- Fees A filing fee of \$250 must accompany this application. All checks should be made payable to the North Carolina State Bar Board of Legal Specialization. Rejection or withdrawal of an application will not entitle an applicant to a refund of the fee or any part of the fee. Late applications received between September 1 and December 31, 2015, will be accepted with an <u>additional</u> \$250 late filing fee. Applications received after December 31, 2015, will not be accepted.
- Filing Timeliness The application shall be considered timely filed if the application is delivered to the office of the North Carolina State Bar before 5:00 p.m. on September 1, 2015, or is postmarked no later than September 1, 2015.

#### 4. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION FORM

**A. PLEASE ANSWER EACH QUESTION.** If additional space is needed to answer a question, please attach pages to the application.

**B. WAIVER of STRICT COMPLIANCE** – If an applicant cannot meet the requirements for substantial involvement or CLE for the applicant's specialty, a waiver of strict compliance may be requested. To do so, you must complete the waiver of strict compliance form, available at <a href="http://www.nclawspecialists.gov/forms.asp">http://www.nclawspecialists.gov/forms.asp</a> and submit the form with your application.

**C. REFERENCES** - Each applicant for recertification is asked to submit the names and addresses of 10 references in support of his or her application. It is preferred that references have experience in the applicable specialty. The extent of a reference's involvement in the applicable specialty and relationship to the applicant will be considered in the evaluation process. All references will be contacted by the Board of Legal Specialization, or its representatives, and asked to complete written peer reference statements. A minimum of 5 peer reference statements must be returned to the Board in order for an application to advance. Reference forms will be sent to the address you provide; please confirm with your reference that the address is correct. The Board, or its representatives, may contact, in person or by telephone, any reference listed by an applicant or any other lawyer or judge qualified to evaluate the applicant's competence and qualification in the specialty area. You are encouraged to advise your peer references (judges and lawyers) that you have listed them on this application and to confirm that they are willing to respond to a peer reference request.

**D. APPLICATION SUPPLEMENT** - Please note the specialties marked with an asterisk(\*) on the following page and submit the application supplement, available on the website, <u>http://www.nclawspecialists.gov/forms/asp</u>, with your application in those specialty areas.
